Residence Agreement

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Residents must maintain full-time status as students of the University of Saskatchewan (enrolled in at least 60% of their program).
- The Online Unit Condition Report must be completed and submitted online within seven days of move-in. There is a \$100 fee if the form is not submitted.
- Residents that move out prior to the end of their Residence Agreement term end date are subject to a \$300 Early Residence Agreement Termination Fee.
- Sixty (60) days' notice to vacate is required by submitting a Notice to Vacate form online.
- By accepting the Residence Agreement, residents are also agreeing to the community standards and Residence guidelines outlined in the Residence Handbook.
- **You are responsible to pay for damage caused in your unit.** Protect yourself and get tenant insurance. Some Canadian students may be covered under their parent's insurance.

Resident Assistants (RAs)

- RAs are the first source of student support in Residence
- RA on duty can be found (in their green vests) in the RA office located in each Residence
- RA on duty can be contacted by cell phone between 7 pm and 7 am (phone numbers in Residence Handbook and on Residence website)
- Provide roommate meetings developing expectations, chore distribution and guidelines
- Provide programming allowing students to socialize and connect with their community, gaining learning and/or cultural experiences
- Assist with challenges, conflicts, personal difficulties, service referral, conduct concerns and more
- Report to professional staff (Coordinators of Student Life) who live in Residence and remain on-call 24 hours/day to respond to emergencies and provide high level of support



Safety in Residence

- Residence patrols are conducted by both Protective Services and RAs
- Security cameras in Residence
- Secure rooms/keycard access
- Students are considered adults in the university context and confidentiality/privacy of information is maintained
- Students wishing to provide consent for parents/supporters to obtain information about them or their time in Residence must contact their Coordinator, Student Life directly to discuss signing a consent form from Protective Services

Room Selection Timeslot Offers

Applicants will receive a timeslot letter by email providing the time and date for applicants to log on to the Residence Housing Portal and select their unit.

Timeslot Offer letters also provide applicants with information about the Room Offer Acceptance Fee (ROAF) that must be paid to reserve the unit prior to the deadline provided.

MAY TO JULY



Acceptance payment (ROAF) required

The ROAF amount is equivalent to one month's rent and is applied to the term rental fees.

Residence Agreement

The Residence Agreement outlines the terms of residency at USask. Agreements will be available to residents following their ROAF payment.

The Residence Agreement must be read prior to accepting the terms online through the Residence Housing Portal.
