- RAs provide referrals, and connections, to the wide range of professional supports available in Residence and the wider campus community.

Safety in Residence

- Residence patrols are conducted by both Protective Services and RAs.
- Security cameras in Residence.
- Secure rooms/keycard access.
- Students are considered adults in the university context and confidentiality/privacy of information is maintained.
- Students wishing to provide consent for parents/supporters to obtain information about them or their time in Residence must contact their Coordinator, Student Life directly to discuss signing a consent form from Protective Services.
